



2010 Pueblo Motorsports Park Pit Vehicle Registration and Agreement

As dictated by our insurance carrier and the National Hot Rod Association (NHRA) for 2010, Pueblo Motorsports Park requires that all pit and other unlicensed or off-road vehicles have a Pueblo Motorsports Park season sticker prominently displayed on the vehicle and a registration agreement on file with the Pueblo Motorsports Park offices. In consideration for being permitted to utilize and operate a motorized pit vehicle on the Pueblo Motorsports Park premises at any 2010 season event or activity, the vehicle owner and/or competition entrant:

- Hereby acknowledges that the use of motorized pit vehicles is dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage.
- Acknowledges and agrees that the vehicle shall be operated in compliance with the vehicle manufacturer's operating instructions and/or industry standards including those regarding riding/driving position and number of passengers.
- Hereby assumes full responsibility for and assumes the risk of bodily injury, death, or property damage arising out of or related to the use of said vehicles whether caused by the negligence of owner and/or their operators, NHRA, Pueblo Motorsports Park, other pit vehicle operators or otherwise.
- Acknowledges and agrees that all operators of said vehicles shall be at least 16 years old, have a valid state required driving license, and carry adequate general liability insurance applicable to the operation of their pit vehicles and that all operators shall provide such license, proof of insurance, and other applicable credentials upon request of a Pueblo Motorsports Park or event official.
- Acknowledges that all registered pit vehicles MUST display the owner's competition number and registration tag in a clearly visible location/manner at all times while on PMP grounds.
- Agrees that the pit vehicle will be operated in a responsible manner and according to all additional Pueblo Motorsports Park regulations and instructions, including but not limited to posted speed limits, and hours of and allowed locations for operations.
- Acknowledges and agrees that unsafe or improper operation of the pit vehicles and/or any violation of regulations and instructions may, at the sole discretion of Pueblo Motorsports Park, result in penalties against the owner and/or operators including but not limited to immediate impoundment of the pit vehicle, loss of pit vehicle privileges for the season, loss of racing privileges for the day, or loss of racing privileges for the season.
